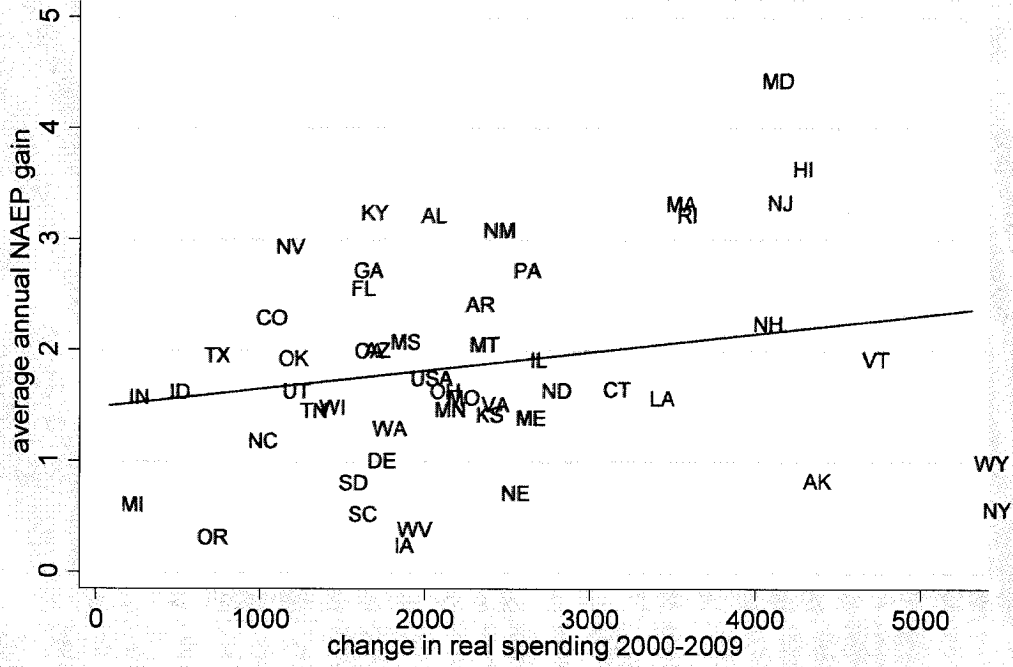

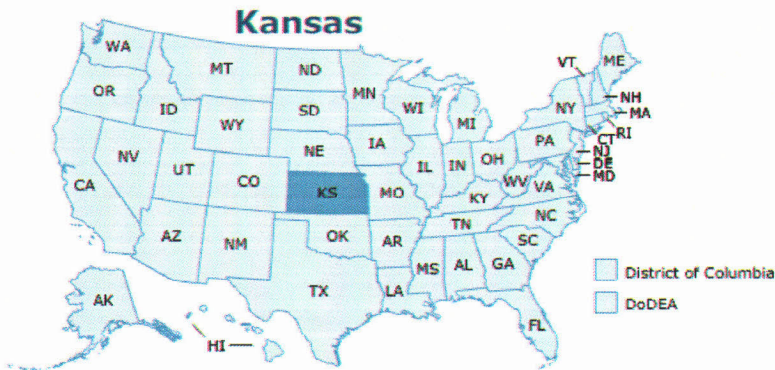

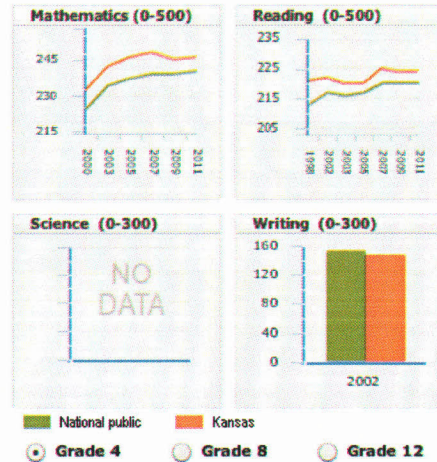

Mathematics: The percentage of students in Kansas who performed at or above the NAEP Basic level was 90 percent in 2011. This percentage was not significantly different from that in 2009 (89 percent) and was greater than that in 2000 (76 percent).
