Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (b) The agencies named in this act are hereby authorized to initiate and complete the capital improvement projects specified and authorized by this act or for which appropriations are made by this act, subject to the restrictions and limitations imposed by this act.

(c) This act shall not be subject to the provisions of subsection (a) of K.S.A. 75-6702, and amendments thereto.


