SUBJECT:

School Finance—Consumer Price Index-Urban

When the 2006 Kansas Legislature approved the three-year school finance plan, they included a provision for increases in state aid, excluding special education, for the fourth year. The law provides that school districts are to receive an increase in state aid for the 2009-2010 school year based upon the percentage increase of the Consumer Price Index-Urban (CPI-U) during the preceding fiscal year as certified to the Commissioner of Education by the Director of the Budget and the Director of the Legislative Research Department on August 15.

The special education law provides that the Legislature fund 92 percent of excess cost.

Listed below are the CPI-U percentage increases for the first ten months of fiscal year 2008.
